

National Disability Insurance Scheme Fact Sheet

For TJW Clients, Parents and Carers

The NDIS is being rolled out across NSW between 1 July 2016 and 30 June 2018.

From 1 July 2016, people living in South Western Sydney and Western Sydney will be able to access the NDIS.

Until the NDIS becomes available in our area your current disability supports and funding will continue.

Transition Timeline

People living in a group home or supported accommodation, will be one of the first to access the NDIS in our area.

The majority of people currently receiving <u>specialist disability</u> <u>supports</u> will be able to access the NDIS in the first 6 months from 1 July 2016.

<u>Specialist disability supports</u> include day programs, case management, accommodation services, and community access services.

The NSW Government has said that no one will be disadvantaged in the move to the NDIS.

People who access specialist disability supports from time-to-time, or for a short amount of time each week, will be able to access the NDIS throughout the rollout period.

People already receiving ADHC funded disability supports <u>will not</u> need to apply for access to the NDIS, but will go through a simplified access process.
